And as we reviewed past participants lists, including as they do the likes of FTSE, Deutsche Boerse, Toronto Stock Exchange, Hang Seng Indexes, Ossiam, Stoxx, BNP Paribas, Johannesburg Stock Exchange, the Abu Dhabi Investment Authority, Tokyo Stock Exchange, Royal Bank of Canada, Nomura, Dubai International Finance Center, Itau, Bovespa and others, the team here found it to be a compelling argument.

Recognizing that the landscape of global investing is changing – the recent financial crisis and the subsequent regulatory changes catalyzed this shift, although it was arguably taking place long before – asset allocators, managers, product providers and the entire gamut of the industry now look at their business and execute their strategies through a global lens. Information Management Network is doing likewise and it is with this in mind that we are excited to announce the renaming of our seventeenth annual gathering: Global Indexing & ETFs: The **Preeminent Investment Management Conference.**






